





"Good night Tessa."

# The next morning.




Tessa wakes up but her mother is not there.




Tessa flies off to look for her mother.

# Tessa flies over the park.




But her mother is not there.

### Tessa flies over the beach.




But her mother is not there.

### Tessa flies over the zoo.




But she can't see her mother.

## Tessa flies over the shops.




But her mother is not there, either.

## It starts to get dark.




Sadly, Tessa flies back to her tree.




"I'm glad you are here", said Tessa. "I've missed you!". Tessa and her mother lived happily ever after.
